

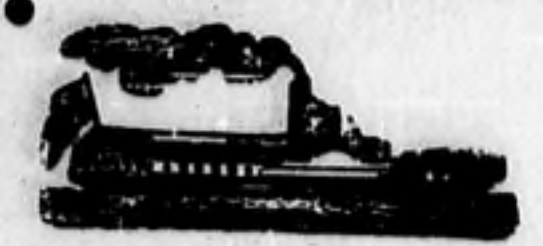

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Rufus C. Palmer of Buffalo N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with Geo W. Holt, Geo W. Coats and the Estate of the late William Huston of the same place and the Estate of the late Robert Hunter of Albany

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the Henry Norton wherof R. P. Robbins is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at in the state of Ohio in the year 1834 as appears by An Enrolment dated at this Port the 22^d day of April 1840 and numbered five & now purchased having changed owners

And The said Enrolment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One Deck and two Masts and that her length is Eighty four feet her breadth Twenty three feet and one inch her depth Eight feet and ten inches and that she measures One hundred fifty tons Eighty three ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has no galley and head.

And the said Rufus C. Palmer having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
