

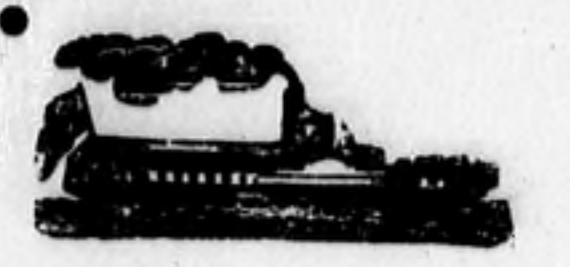

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 13th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

*George A. Moore* of Buffalo N.Y. --  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with *Samuel H. Davis and Jay and Miller* of the same place

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Ship \_\_\_\_\_ or Vessel called the *Superior of Buffalo* whereof *John Munson Jr.* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn \_\_\_\_\_ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Waukegan* in the year 1837 as appears by Her Enrollment dated at this Port the 11th day of October 1841 No 42 now Surrendered having changed Owners

And The said Enrollment \_\_\_\_\_ having certified that the said Ship \_\_\_\_\_ or vessel has *One Deck* and *Three Masts* and that her length is *One hundred twenty eight feet* her breadth *Twenty nine feet* her depth *Five feet and eight inches* and that she measures *Three hundred fifty eight tons eighty eight ninety-fifths* that she is a Ship \_\_\_\_\_ has \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ *Figure head.*

And the said *George A. Moore* \_\_\_\_\_ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Ship \_\_\_\_\_ has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
