IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Charles S. Lee
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the
Savannah of Edward Green Schooner Thomas M. Cumber
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at place Green in
1836, & rebuilt in the year 1842 as appears by the Enrollment dated
at this Port 10th of May 1842 No 24 now surrendered having
changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that
the said Schooner or vessel has One Deck and two Mast and that her
length is eighty four feet and nine inches
her breadth thirty two feet
her depth seven feet and two inches
and that she measures One hundred eighty seven tons seventy eight ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner has no gallery
and has a screw head.

And the said Charles S. Lee having
agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
