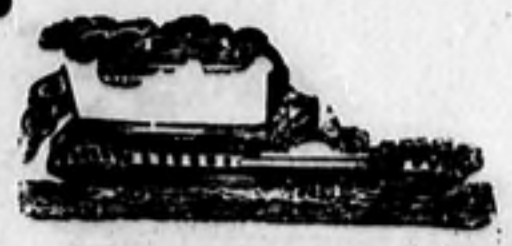

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

William P. Talbot of New York
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with Horatio W. Farnham and James Clark of the same place and Tapp & Parks of Cleveland Ohio

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the
Henry Prop of New York whereof David Clark is at present Master and, as he hath sworn is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at New York in 1835 & rebuilt in the year 1842 as appears by the certificate of Wm P. Talbot and Wm Enrolment dated at the Port of Buffalo N.Y. May 12th 1842 No 25, now surrendered having changed name & been rebuilt
And the said Certificate and Enrolment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One Deck and Two Mast and that her length is twenty four feet four inches her breadth thirteen feet six inches her depth eight feet three and a half inches and that she measures One hundred three tons Nineteen ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has no galley and screw head.

And the said William P. Talbot having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
