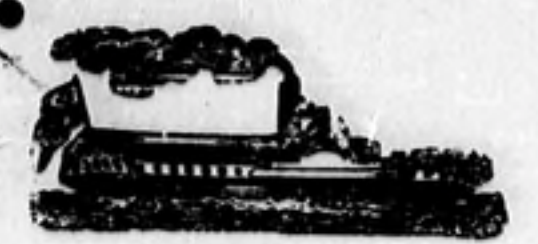

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

William Jones of Black River Ohio
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with *Chancy Tucker of Fredonia N.Y.*

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Schooner _____ or Vessel called the *James G. King* whereof *J. W. M. Queen* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn _____ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Dunkirk New York* in the year *1836* as appears by Her Enrollment dated at this Port the *23rd* day of *May 1842* No *29* now surrendered having changed colour _____ And the said Enrollment _____ having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Eighty four feet* her breadth *Twenty three feet and one inch* her depth *nine feet* and that she measures *One hundred & fifty three tons* *thirty four* ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner _____ has no Gallies _____ and _____ head.

And the said *William Jones* having agreed to the description and advertisement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner _____ has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
