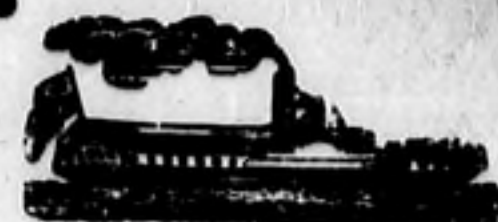

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Myron Gage of Sillow Creek N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with *Charles Nantely* of the same place being

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Oceanus of Sillow Creek* whereof *Myron Gage* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built in 1812 for a Canal Port & rebuilt at Sillow Creek in the year 1842 as appears by the certificate of *Charles Nantely* of Sillow Creek filed in this office and dated the 22^d day of July 1843

And the said *Charles Nantely* having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has *One Deck* and length is *Seventy seven feet and Six inches* her breadth *Thirteen feet and Nine inches* her depth *five feet and Eleven inches* and that she measures *fifty nine* tons *thirty seven ninety-fifths* that she is a *Schooner* has *No* galley and *Square* head.

And the said *Myron Gage* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
