

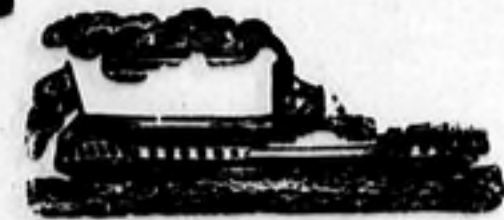

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Jno. G. Brown of Buffalo, Erie Co. New York
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the
Jesse Smith whereof Warren Grodavant
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at French Creek,
New York in the year 1832 as appears by the Enrollment
dated at Detroit the 12 day of June 1843. No. 15 now surren-
-dered reason of a change of Owner
And the said Enrollment having certified that
the said Schooner or vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her
length is Seventy nine feet ten inches 79-10
her breadth Nineteen feet & two inches 19-2
her depth Eight feet & six inches 8-6
and that she measures One hundred & twenty tons less by Six ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner has no Gallies
and a full head.

And the said Jno. G. Brown having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
