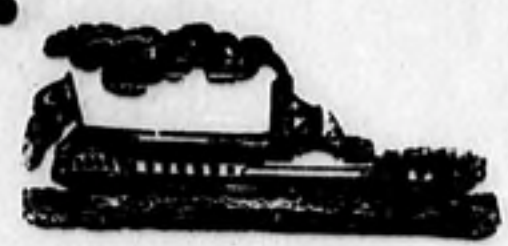

IN CONFORMITY TO
An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing
Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and
Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for
other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives
of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Walter J. J. of Buffalo N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is
with Guy B. Webb of the same place being

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the
Sandusky whereof J. P. Dawson
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at the city of Sandusky
Ohio in the year 1834, as appears by the Enrollment dated
at the Port of Buffalo N.Y. Nov 2^d 1835. No 64, now surrendered
having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that
the said Schooner or vessel has One Deck and two Masts and that her
length is Twenty six feet and two inches
her breadth twenty one feet and four inches
her depth seven feet and nine inches
and that she measures One hundred & two tons thirty four ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner has no Gallies
and a screw head.

And the said Walter J. J. having
agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
