IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Albert T. Morgan
 having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with Moses Fuller of Silver Creek N.Y. being

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the
Barcelona wherof *John Reid*
 is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a
 Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Sarnville*
Canada in the year 1826 as appears by the Enrollment dated
 at this Port 18th of August 1842 No 41 now surrendered
 having changed owners
 And the said Enrollment having certified that
 the said Schooner or vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her
 length is *Twenty four feet and nine inches*
 her breadth *Seven feet and four inches*
 her depth *Two feet and ten inches*
 and that she measures *Eighty nine* tons *Seven* hundred *four* ninety-fifths
 that she is a Schooner has no sails and a *shell* head.

And the said Albert T. Morgan of Buffalo having
 agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-
 mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at
 the Port of Buffalo Creek.
