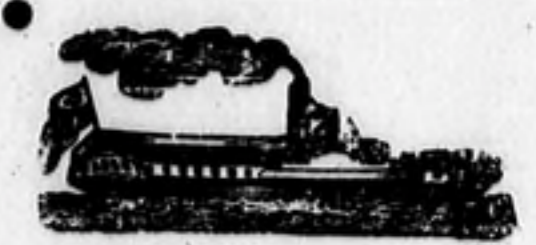

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES Sole owner of the Schooner _____ or Vessel called the *Mariam of Buffalo* whereof *N. Vail* _____ is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn _____ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Silver Creek New York* _____ in the year 1840, as appears by the Oath of *N. Vail* Shipwright filed in this Office Sept 4th 1843.

Vail* _____ having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Fifty Six feet and four inches* _____ her breadth *Eighteen feet and five inches* _____ her depth *Six feet and no inches* _____ and that she measures *Fifty Two* _____ tons *Sixty four* _____ ninety-fifths: that she is a Schooner _____ has *no galleries* _____ and a *Scow* _____ head.

And the said *N. Vail* _____ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner _____ has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
