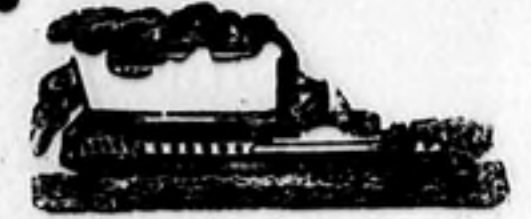

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

John S. Edmunds of Buffalo N.Y.
Having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he *coffice* with Silman Appleby of the same place being

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Steam Boat or Vessel called the Benjamin Franklin whereof John S. Edmunds is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn, is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1842 as appears by the Enrollment dated at this Port the 27th day of April 1845, and now amended having changed name to _____ and the said Enrollment _____ having certified that the said Steam Boat or vessel has One Deck and _____ and that her length is One hundred and thirty five feet _____ her breadth Nineteen feet and two inches _____ her depth Nine feet _____ and that she measures One hundred and thirty one tons Twenty eight ninety-fifths: that she is a Steam Boat has no Gallies _____ and a Scroll _____ head.

And the said John S. Edmunds _____ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat _____ has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
