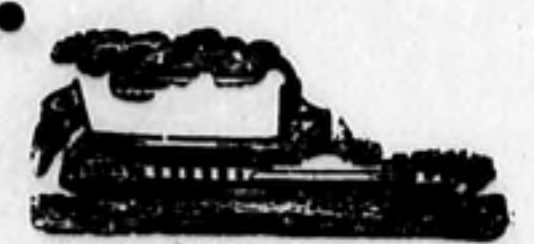




ENROLLMENT.

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Ossamus Haver of Buffalo Erie County New York
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the *Bague* or Vessel called the
Sandusky whereof *Charles C. Marsh* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Sandusky* in 1834
re built & altered to a *Bague* from a Steam Boat in the year 1841 as appears by his Certificate of Ownership
Manu filed in this Office and dated the tenth day of October 1843
and his Enrollment dated at *Portland* April 1st 1839
Surrendered having changed names
And the last Certificate of Enrollment having certified that
the said *Bague* or vessel has *One Deck* and *Three Masts* and that her
length is *One Hundred and forty eight feet*
her breadth *Twenty six feet and six inches*
her depth *Seven feet and one inch*
and that she measures *Three hundred Seventy seven tons Tons* ninety-fifths
that she is a *Bague* has *one* gun
and has a *Figure* head.

And the said *Ossamus Haver* having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Bague* has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
