IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

That *John C Hawley of Buffalo N.Y.* having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is Attorney for *Lewis Benedict, Spencer S. Benedict & Walter M. Rockwood of Albany N.Y.* and that the said *Lewis Benedict, Spencer S. Benedict, & Walter M. Rockwood* together with *Nathaniel W. Brown of Ohio* being

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the *Brig* or Vessel called the *Mispow* whereof *Nathaniel W. Brown* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Yarmillion Ohio* in the year 1842 as appears by Her Enrollment dated at the Port of Portland the 1st day of August 1842 A.D. now surrendered having changed owner

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said *Brig* or vessel has *One Deck* and *two Masts* and that her length is *Eighty three feet* her breadth *Twenty feet & four inches* her depth *Eight feet* and that she measures *One hundred & twenty one* tons *twenty seven* ninety-fifths that she is a *Brig* has *no* gallies and *scull* head.

And the said *John C Hawley* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Brig* has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
