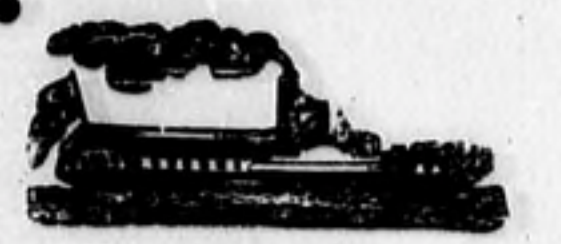

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Harry Whittaker of Buffalo N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Steam Boat _____ or Vessel called the _____ United States _____ whereof Harry Whittaker _____ is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn _____ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Huron _____ Ohio _____ in the year 1834 as appears by Her Enrolment dated at Cleveland October 3rd 1813. No. 48. now surrendered by reason of change of owner _____ and the said Enrolment _____ having certified that the said Steam Boat or vessel has One Deck _____ and One Mast _____ and that her length is One hundred & forty feet _____ her breadth Twenty eight & four inches _____ her depth Ten feet _____ and that she measures Three hundred & fifty six tons eighty _____ ninety-fifths: that she is a Steam Boat _____ has no Gally _____ and a Scroll _____ head.

And the said Harry Whittaker _____ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat _____ has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
