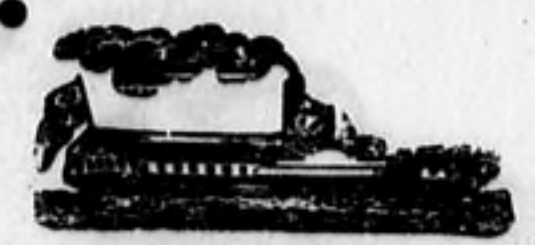

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Samuel N. Callender of Buffalo Erie Co New York
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the
Ocean of Buffalo whereof John W. Miller
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Maumee
Ohio in the year 1837 as appears by Her Enrollment dated
at this Port the fifteenth day of June 1842. No 55 now
sundered having changed owner

And The said Enrollment having certified that
the said Schooner or vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her
length is Eighty three feet and six inches
her breadth Twenty three feet and four inches
her depth Nine feet and no inches
and that she measures One hundred and fifty three tons Eighty nine-fifths
that she is a Schooner has no Gallies
and a Scull head.

And the said Samuel N. Callender having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
