An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Thomas L. Parker of Buffalo N.Y.,  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Brig \_\_\_\_\_ or Vessel called the  
Indiana of Buffalo whereof Thomas L. Parker  
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn \_\_\_\_\_ is a  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River  
Ohio \_\_\_\_\_ in the year 1837 as appears by New Enrollment dated  
at this Port March 15<sup>th</sup> 1842 No. 2 now surrendered

And the said Enrollment \_\_\_\_\_ having certified that  
the said Brig \_\_\_\_\_ or vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her  
length is Sixty Eight feet and Nine inches \_\_\_\_\_

and that she measures Two Hundred fifteen tons Forty Four ninety-fifths

And the said Thomas L. Parker \_\_\_\_\_ having  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-  
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig \_\_\_\_\_ has been duly enrolled at  
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
