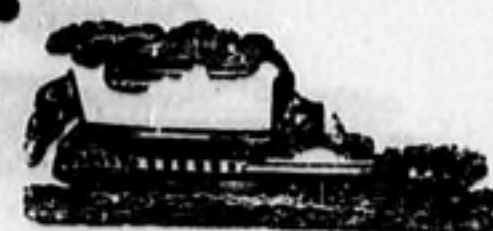

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers, on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a
with Winaw Harrison of the same place

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the
Felic of Irving whereof James W. Gates
is at present Master; And, as he hath sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Irving
New York in the year 1841 as appears by Her Enrollment dated
at this Port the 5th day of February 1844. N. Y. now surrendered
Having changed Owner

And The said Enrollment having certified that
the said Schooner or vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her
length is Twenty one feet and six inches
her breadth Thirteen feet and Three inches
her depth Five feet and four inches
and that she measures Fifty Seven tons Eight two ninety fifths
that she is a Schooner has no Ballast
and no figure head.

And the said James W. Gates having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
