

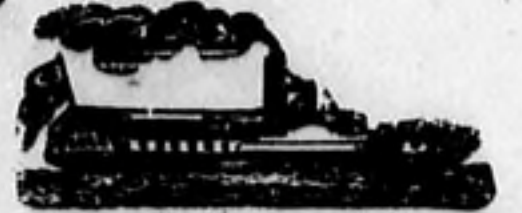

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Benjamin Knowlidge of Buffalo County of Ohio and State of New York having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner _____ or Vessel called the Texas of Buffalo _____ whereof Benjamin Knowlidge is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn _____ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River Ohio _____ in the year 1838 as appears by New Enrollment dated at this Port June 5th 1843, No 17, now amended having changed names

And the said Enrollment _____ having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has two Decks and two Masts and that her length is Seventy eight feet and three inches, her breadth Twenty three feet two and a half inches, her depth Eight feet and seven inches, and that she measures One hundred thirty four tons Sixty nine-fifths, that she is a Schooner has no gallies _____ and a Stern _____ head.

And the said Benjamin Knowlidge _____ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner _____ has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
