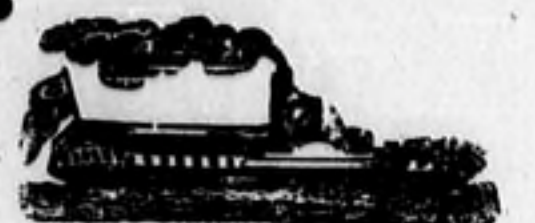

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Amiel R. Cobb of Buffalo N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with Samuel W. Atwater, and Robert Montgomery of the same place being

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the *Brig* _____ or Vessel called the *S. P. Ruggles* _____ whereof *Robert Montgomery* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn _____ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Seneca Falls New York* in the year 1837 as appears by *Her Enrollment* dated at the Port August 26th 1843. now surrendered having changed owners.

And the said Enrollment _____ having certified that the said *Brig* _____ or vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Thirty feet and two inches* her breadth *Twenty four feet and two inches* her depth *Five feet and five inches* and that she measures *One Hundred & Eighty three tons Twenty four ninety-fifths* that she is a *Brig* _____ has *no gallies* _____ and a *Scull* _____ head.

And the said *Amiel R. Cobb* _____ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Brig* _____ has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
