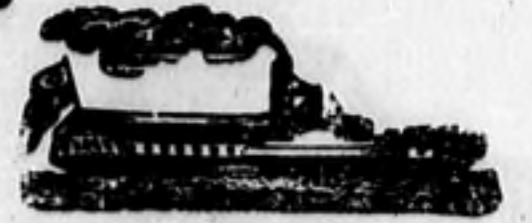

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

John McEachary of Buffalo N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Wm Woodbridge* whereof *D. T. Robbins* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Warren Ohio* in the year 1841 as appears by *Her Enrollment dated at the Port of Portland Ohio the 14th day of April 1843*. Now surrendered having changed owner

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Seventy Nine Feet and Six inches*, her breadth *Twenty Feet and Four inches*, her depth *Eight Feet and Three inches*, and that she measures *One Hundred Seventeen tons Ninety three ninety fifths*; that she is a *Schooner* has *no Gallies* and *a Stern* head.

And the said *John McEachary* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this *Twenty fifth* day of *April* in the year one thousand eight hundred and *forty four*
