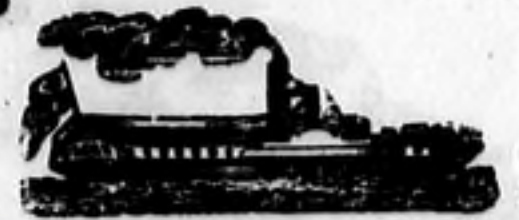

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Samuel W. Shelton of Buffalo New York,
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with
Nehemiah Randall of the same place, A. B. Northrup, M. Maywood,
of the City of Rochester, Erasmus S. Passer, Edmund Hines, P. H.
Kurt, and C. M. Tomlinson of the City of Albany, S. Carle of the
City of New York (N.Y.), and S. Goulds, of Concord Ohio, being

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Steam Boat or Vessel called the
Wisconsin of Buffalo whereof Nehemiah Randall
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Concord in 1843 and
rebuilt at Buffalo in the year 1843 as appears by the Certificate of A. D.
Stebbins, dated at this Port April 1st 1844, and filed in this
Office,

And A. D. Stebbins Surveyor, having certified that
the said Steam Boat or vessel has Two Decks and One Mast and that her
length is Two Hundred and eighteen feet and eight inches,
her breadth Thirty feet
her depth Fourteen feet
and that she measures Eight Hundred & eighty seven tons Ninety
that she is a Steam Boat has no gallery
and a Screw

And the said Samuel W. Shelton having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.

in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-four
