

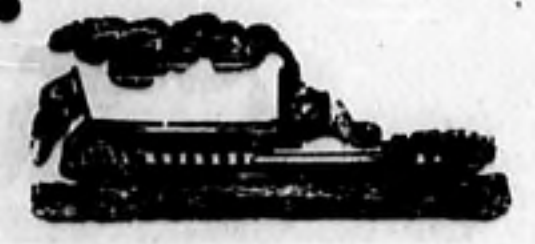

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the
George Watson whereof A. W. Ward is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Charleston Ohio in the year 1841 as appears by the Enrollment dated at the Port of Cleveland 8th June 1843 N.Y. now surrendered having changed arms.

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is Seventy eight feet her breadth Nineteen feet four and a half inches her depth Six feet seven and a half inches and that she measures sixty one tons & thirty seven ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has no gallies, a Square Stern and no figure head.

And the said James N. Morgan having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
