IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Orsamus Mann of Buffalo City Co New York,
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with John Day of the same place,

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the *Banyard* or Vessel called the *Samuel Key* of Buffalo whereof John Day is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Samuel Key in 1834 rebuilt & altered to a *Banyard* in the year 1843 as appears by Men's Enrollment dated at this Port the tenth day of October 1843 No 43 now surrendered having changed names.

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said *Banyard* or vessel has One Deck and Three Masts and that her length is One Hundred and forty eight feet her breadth Twenty six feet and six inches her depth Ten feet and one inch and that she measures Three Hundred Seventy seven tons Twelve and that she is a *Banyard* has no galleries and has a figure head.

And the said Orsamus Mann having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Banyard* has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
