IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

George B. Webster of Buffalo New York
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is acquainted with Walter J. J. of the same place and Nathan C. Winslow, of Cleveland Ohio being;

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Brig Rocky Mountain or Vessel called the Rocky Mountain whereof Edward Curtis is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Green Bay in the year 1837, as appears by New Enrollment dated at Cleveland August 1st 1841 No. 35. now surrendered having changed District;

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is One Hundred feet and six inches, her breadth Twenty eight feet, her depth Nine feet and Ten inches and that she measures Two Hundred & forty two tons Sixty Nine ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has no gallery, a Square Stern and a figure head.

And the said George B. Webster having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this thirteenth day of May in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-four
