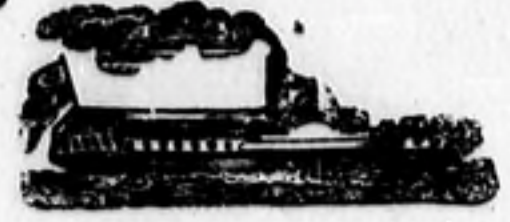

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Henry M. Kime of Buffalo, Erie Co New York,  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with  
Jacob Omsen of Dunkirk New York being

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Brig \_\_\_\_\_ or Vessel called the  
Empire of Buffalo, \_\_\_\_\_ whereof Jacob Omsen, \_\_\_\_\_  
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn \_\_\_\_\_ is a  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at \_\_\_\_\_  
Ohio \_\_\_\_\_ in the year 1844 as appears by the Certificate of  
William Treat Master Carpenter dated at \_\_\_\_\_ May \_\_\_\_\_  
1844, and filed in this office

And the said Certificate \_\_\_\_\_ having certified that  
the said Brig \_\_\_\_\_ or vessel has One Deck and Two Masts—and that her  
length is One Hundred and Twenty five feet seven inches—  
her breadth Twenty six feet and eleven inches—  
her depth Nine feet and seven inches—  
and that she measures Two Hundred and Sixty Seven Tons Ninety fifths—  
that she is a Brigantine Built has no Gallies—  
\_\_\_\_\_ and a Stern \_\_\_\_\_ head.

And the said Henry M. Kime \_\_\_\_\_ having  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-  
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig \_\_\_\_\_ has been duly enrolled at  
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
