

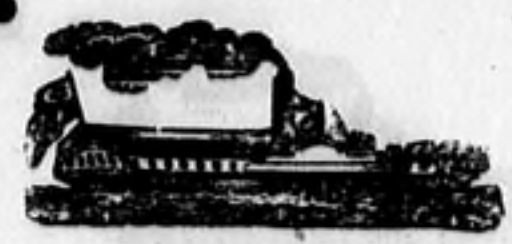

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels protected in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

John Wellons of Black Rock N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with *Absolom Bull and Jared Jennings* of the same place and *James C. Stoneall* of New York being

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Steam Boat or Vessel called the *Matamor* of Black Rock whereof *Jared Jennings* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn *James C. Stoneall* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black Rock in 1844 and rebuilt in the year 1844 as appears by the Certificate of *A. J. Robbins* Surveyor dated at the Port of Buffalo May 11th 1844,

And the said Certificate having certified that the said Steam Boat or vessel has One Deck and No Mast and that her length is One Hundred and twenty five feet her breadth Eighteen feet and four inches her depth Six feet and four inches and that she measures One Hundred and twenty tons Seventy two ninety-fifths that she is a Steam Boat has no gallery and a Figure head.

And the said *John Wellons* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Steam Boat* has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this *Eleventh* day of *May* in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty *four*
