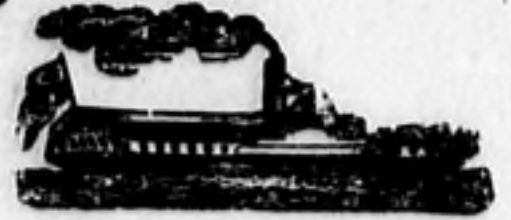

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Fernando C. Owen of Silver Creek N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with *Henry W. Kime of Buffalo N.Y.* being

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Miss of Silver Creek* whereof *Fernando C. Owen* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Silver Creek N.Y.* in the year 1844 as appears by the Certificate of *A. D. Sebbins* Surveyor dated *May 14th 1844* and filed in this office

And the said Certificate having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one Deck and two Masts and that her length is *Ninety feet and six inches*, her breadth *Twenty two feet and three inches*, her depth *Seven feet and ten inches*, and that she measures *One Hundred forty one tons fifty one* ninety-fifths: that she is a Schooner has no gallies and a Figure head.

And the said *Fernando C. Owen* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
