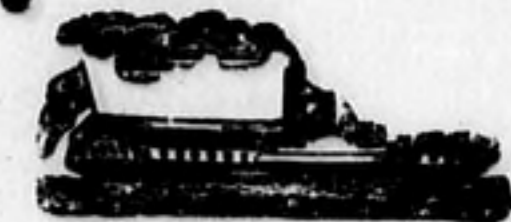

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

*Sylvester Staring* of Buffalo Erie County New York  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together  
with *Richard Liddle* of the same place being

*District of Buffalo Creek  
Port of Buffalo*  
Arrived at this Port May 22<sup>d</sup> 1846 having changed  
owners and name *from [illegible] to [illegible]*

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Steam Boat or Vessel called the  
*Indian Queen* of Buffalo whereof *Sylvester Staring* is  
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo  
*New York* in the year 1841 as appears by the Certificate of  
*J. N. Banta* Master *William* dated 27<sup>th</sup> May 1844 and filed  
in this office

And the said Certificate having certified that  
the said Steamboat or vessel has Two Decks and One Mast and that her  
length is One Hundred feet and nine inches  
her breadth Fifteen feet and Eleven inches  
her depth Seven feet and four inches  
and that she measures One Hundred & Twelve tons Tons ninety-fifths  
that she is a Steam Boat has no gallery  
and no head

And the said *Sylvester Staring* having  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-  
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat has been duly enrolled at  
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
