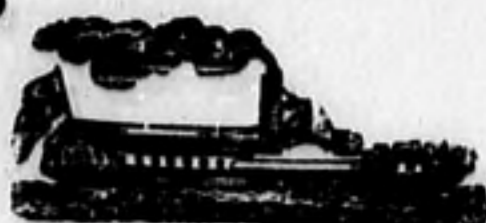

Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and  
Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for  
other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives  
of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

*N.Y. N.Y.* in the year 1811 as appears by the Certificate of  
*Thomas N. Ellis* dated 28<sup>th</sup> May 1844 and filed in this  
Office,  
And the said *Thomas N. Ellis* having certified that  
the said *Shoop* or vessel has *One Deck* and *One Mast* and that her  
length is *Fifty Five* feet and *four* inches.  
her breadth *Nineteen* feet  
her depth *Six* feet and *seven* and a *half* inches.  
and that she measures *Fifty Eight* tons *Twenty* ninety-fifths.  
that she is a *Shoop* has *no* gallies and has a *Screw* head.

And the said *James Butler* having  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-  
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Shoop* has been duly enrolled at  
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
