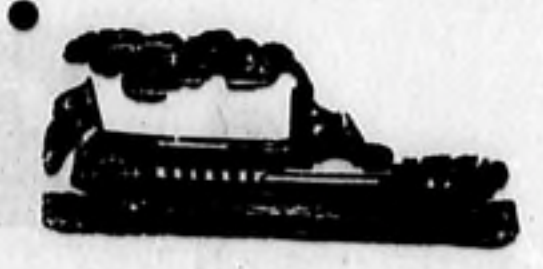

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Olinus Fox of Buffalo Erie Co. N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with Amel R. Cobb of the same place

Captains of the UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Brig Oricola or Vessel called the Oricola whereof A. J. Farnand is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Silver Creek New York. in the year 1837 as appears by Her Enrollment dated at this Port the 21st day of April 1841. N. S. now surrendered having changed owner

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is Eighty eight feet & no inches her breadth Twenty four feet & two inches her depth Three feet and two inches and that she measures One hundred & twenty one tons Thirty seven ninety-fifths: that she is a Brig has no galleries and a scull head.

And the said Olinus Fox having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
