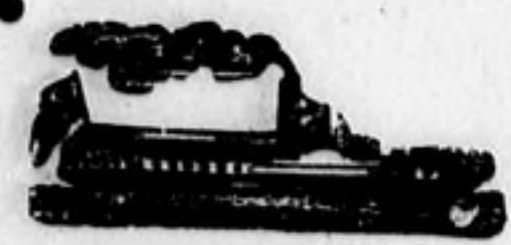

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

John Milkren of Buffalo New York
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with B. F. Davison of the same place being

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole/owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the
Citizens Henry of Buffalo whereof B. F. Davison
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn
is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Mount Clemens
Michigan in the year 1837 as appears by Her Enrolment dated
at this Port June 9th 1843. And further having changed
owners,

And the said Enrolment having certified that
the said Schooner or vessel has One Deck and One Mast, and that her
length is Seventy Feet and six inches
her breadth Twenty One Feet and Eleven inches
her depth Six feet and Ten inches
and that she measures Eighty two tons Thirty Seven ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner has no gallies
and a Stern head.

And the said John Milkren of Buffalo having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
