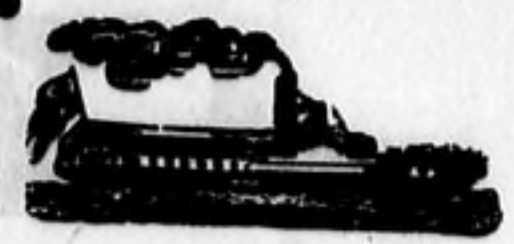




ENROLLMENT.

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Robt. Hollister of Buffalo N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with William Hollister and Amos Pratt of the same place being

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES Sole owners of the Steam Propeller or Vessel called the Jameson of Buffalo whereof Amos Pratt is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Kenjeburg, Ohio in the year 1813 as appears by Her Enrolment dated at Maumee City July 11th 1843. No 3. now run under having changed Districts And the said Enrolment having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has two Decks and two Masts and that her length is One hundred & thirty four feet her breadth Twenty five feet her depth Eight feet and that she measures Two hundred & fifty tons Fifty ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has no gallies and head.

And the said Robt. Hollister having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
