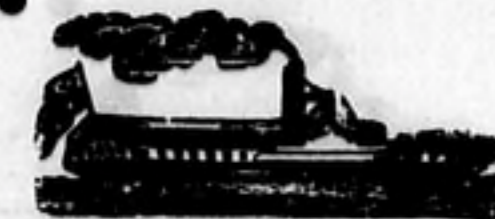

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

George B. Walbridge of Buffalo Erie Co. N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with *Charles Hall and Arny Salisbury of Coscut Ash Cabules Co. Ohio* all being

SOLE OWNERS OF THE *Brig* or Vessel called the

S. C. Walbridge of Buffal wherof *Arny Salisbury* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Coscut Ohio* in the year 1844, as appears by the Certificate of *R. M. Hewitt of Coscut Ohio* Master builder which Certificate is filed in his Office & dated 30th August 1844

And the said Certificate having certified that the said *Brig* vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *One hundred and four feet and six and a half inches* her breadth *Twenty four feet and three and a half inches* her depth *Nine feet and ten and a half inches* and that she measures *Two hundred & Twenty seven tons Sixteen* ninety-fifths that she is a *Brig* has no galleries and has a *Scull* head.

And the said *George B. Walbridge* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Brig* has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this *thirteenth* day of *August* in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty *four*
