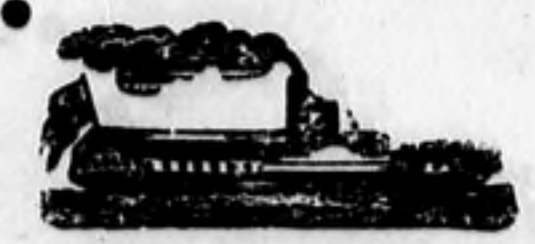

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Rufus C Palmer of Buffalo N.Y. . . . .  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with George W Holt & Giles H Coate of the same place being

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Brig \_\_\_\_\_ or Vessel called the  
Hosier, \_\_\_\_\_ whereof Russell S. Crang \_\_\_\_\_ is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn \_\_\_\_\_ is a  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River, \_\_\_\_\_  
Ohio \_\_\_\_\_ in the year 1842 as appears by Her Enrollment dated  
at the Port of Buffalo N.Y. July 9<sup>th</sup> 1842, No 36. Now surrendered  
having changed owners \_\_\_\_\_  
And the said Enrollment \_\_\_\_\_ having certified that  
the said Brig \_\_\_\_\_ or vessel has one Deck and Two Masts and that her  
length is Ninety five feet and six inches \_\_\_\_\_  
her breadth Twenty four feet and five inches \_\_\_\_\_  
her depth Nine feet and four inches \_\_\_\_\_  
and that she measured One hundred & Ninety three tons ninety \_\_\_\_\_ ninety-fifths:  
that she is A Brig \_\_\_\_\_ has \_\_\_\_\_ gallons \_\_\_\_\_  
\_\_\_\_\_ and has a screw \_\_\_\_\_ head.

And the said Rufus C Palmer \_\_\_\_\_ having  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conform-  
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig \_\_\_\_\_ has been duly enrolled at  
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
