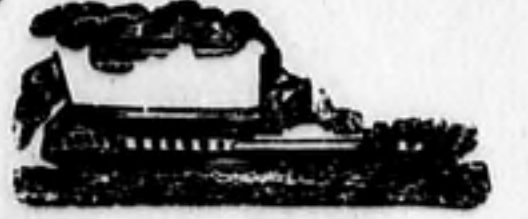

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Charles Lay of Buffalo N.Y.  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with Sophia E. Wait of the same place being

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the North Carolina of Buffalo whereof Abner Abbott is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Sheffield Ohio in the year 1835 as appears by her Enrollment dated at the Port of Buffalo N.Y. 14th October 1842 at 49, measurement having changed amount

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is Seventy three feet and three inches her breadth Twenty five feet and nine inches her depth Seven feet and two inches and that she measures Ninety five tons Fifteen ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has no galleries and a Figure head.

And the said Charles Lay having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
