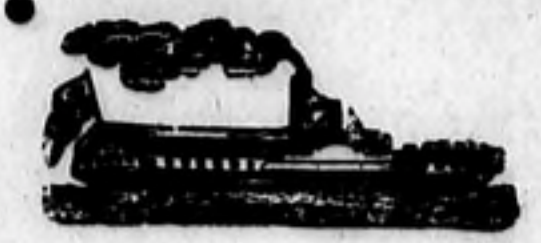

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Shadon Chapin of Buffalo N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Lake Boat or Vessel called the Michigan of Buffalo whereof John Tracy is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Rochester New York in the year 1844 as appears by the Certificate of Seth Jones filed in this Office this day, and the Certificate of S.W. Lathrop Surveyor filed in this Office October 15th 1844.

And the said Certificate having certified that the said Lake Boat or vessel has one Deck and no Mast and that her length is Eighty feet and ten inches her breadth Thirteen feet and nine inches her depth Six feet and seven inches and that she measures Sixty nine tons fifteen ninety fifths that she is a Lake Boat has no Gallies and no figure head.

And the said Shadon Chapin having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Lake Boat has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
