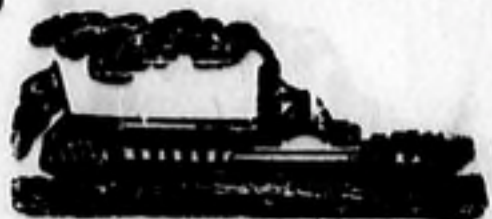




ENROLLMENT.

DISTRICT OF BUFFALO CREEK, PORT OF BUFFALO CREEK.

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

John Yail of Buffalo N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Brig *Uncle Sam* or Vessel called the *Uncle Sam* whereof *John Yail* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Detroit Michigan & built and altered ^{to a Brig at Cleveland Ohio in} in the year 1844 as appears by the Certificate of *John Yail* Owner & Master that the former papers were lost, his Certificate of Admeasurement filed in this Office Nov 9th 1844 & *St. Satchel* Surveyor And the said Certificate having certified that the said Brig or vessel has *One Deck* and *two Mast* and that her length is *One hundred & thirty five* feet and *six* inches her breadth *Twenty three* feet and *four* inches her depth *Seven* feet and *Eleven* inches and that she measures *Two hundred & thirty six* tons *twenty four* ninety-fifths that she is a *Brig* has *no* Ballast and a *scroll* head.

And the said *John Yail* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Brig* has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.



Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this *Ninth* day of *November* in the year one thousand eight hundred and *forty-four*.
