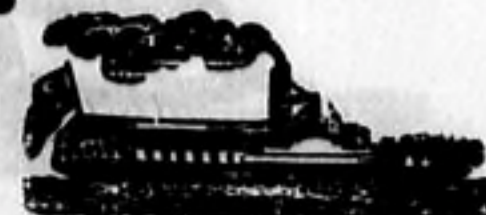

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

N. R. S. Ward of Buffalo, N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with *N. M. Galligan* + *J. W. Mitchell* of Erie Pa.

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES sole owners of the Schooner _____ or Vessel called the *R. C. Smead* whereof *J. W. Mitchell*

is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn _____ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Chermonk Bay New York* in the year 1834 as appears by her Enrollment dated at the Port of *Oswego N.Y.* Sept 4 1844. No 61 now surrendered having changed name _____

And The said Enrollment _____ having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *sixty two feet and six inches* her breadth *Eighteen feet & nine inches* her depth *Seven feet and six inches* and that she measures *Seventy five* tons *Forty and ninety-fifths*: that she is a Schooner has *no Gallies* and a *Scroll* head.

And the said *N. R. S. Ward* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
