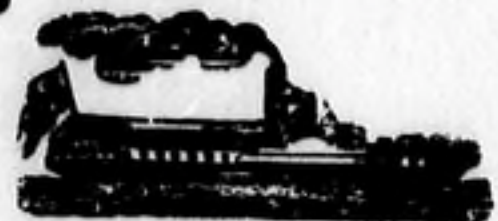

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

John Pease of Buffalo New York
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with John S. Kimberly, Charles Townsend & George Coit of the same place, William V. Pease of Detroit Michigan, Richard M. Standart and David Griffith of Canton Ohio being

Captain of the UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the Buffalo whereof John C. Tyler is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Huron Ohio in the year 1832 as appears by Her Enrollment dated at this Port September 18th 1841 now summ'd having changed owner

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is Ninety two feet and one inch her breadth Twenty feet and four inches her depth Nine feet and a half inches and that she measures One hundred & Sixty one tons fifty eight ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has no galleries and has a Scroll head.

And the said John Pease having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
