IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Samuel W. Hawes of Buffalo N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Brig or Vessel called the
St Louis, whereof John W. Webster

is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at San dusty City,
Ohio in the year 1836 as appears by the Certificate of
John W. Webster filed in this Office April 5th 1845 and of
John A. Lewis Surveyor

And the said Certificate having certified that
the said Brig or vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her
length is Eighty nine feet and two inches
her breadth Twenty four feet and seven inches
her depth Eight feet and seven inches
and that she measures One hundred and sixty five tons thirty one
ninety-fifths
that she is a Brig has
and head.

And the said Samuel W. Hawes having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
