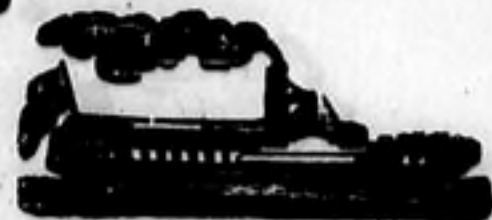

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838. *George T. Webster of Buffalo N.Y.* having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with *Walter Jay of the same place being.*

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES sole owners of the *T. Erie* or Vessel called the *Alert of Buffalo* whereof *William W. Scovill* is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Black River* in *1842* rebuilt at *Buffalo* in the year *1845* as appears by the Enrollment dated at the Port of *Buffalo N.Y.* April 29th 1842, (now surrendered having been rebuilt) as appears the Certificate of *D. T. Sedwell* filed in this Office this day. And the said Enrollment and Certificate having certified that the said *T. Erie* or vessel has *one Deck* and *two Mast* and that her length is *One hundred four feet and eight inches* her breadth *Twenty three feet and one inch* her depth *Eight feet and three & a half inches* and that she measured *One hundred & eighty four* tons *seven* hundred *ninety* fifths: that she is a *T. Erie* *two* Gallies and a *small* head.

And the said *George T. Webster* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *T. Erie* has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this *seven* day of *April* in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty *five*
