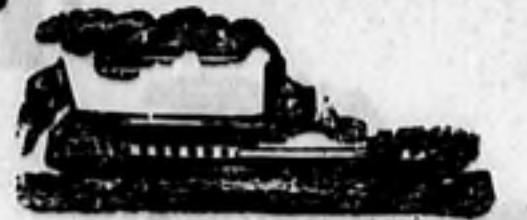

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

John Harrison of Evans Erie Co. N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

OWNER OF THE UNITED STATES sole owner of the Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ or Vessel called the Com Lawrence whereof John Harrison is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn \_\_\_\_\_ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at London Ohio in 1833 rebuilt at Evans NY in the year 1845 as appears by Her Enrollment dated at this the 15th day of May 1845. N.Y. now surrendered having been rebuilt and the certificate of John Harrison & John Norton filed in this Office this 1 day And the said Enrollment certificate \_\_\_\_\_ having certified that the said Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ or vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is Fifty six feet and five inches her breadth Eighteen feet and nine inches her depth Six feet and two inches and that she measures Fifty tons Three nine ninety-fifths: that she is a Schooner has no Gallies \_\_\_\_\_ and a Scull head.

And the said John Harrison having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this Seven day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty five
