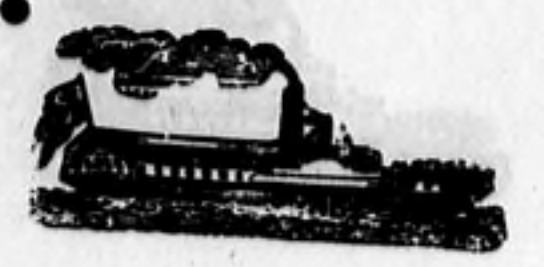

IN CONFORMITY TO
An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing
Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and
Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for
other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives
of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Jeremiah A Peabody of Buffalo N.Y
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the
(Constitution) of Buffalo whereof Edward Curtis
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at French Creek N.Y
in 1835 & rebuilt in the year 1845, as appears by New Enrollment dated
at the Port of Buffalo April 25th 1842. Surrendered having
been rebuilt as appears by the Oath of Asa Kating dated Sept. 28th 1845
and Augustus D. Stebbins
the said Schooner or vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her
length is Eighty seven feet and three inches
her breadth Nineteen feet and eight inches
her depth Eight feet and four inches
and that she measures One hundred thirty five
tons ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner has no galleries
and has a Square head.

And the said Jeremiah A Peabody
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner
the Port of Buffalo Creek. has been duly enrolled at
