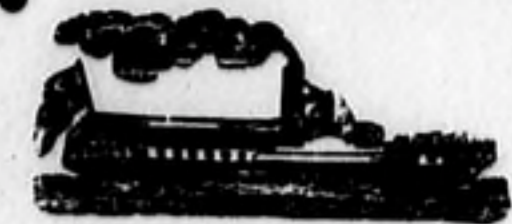




# ENROLLMENT.

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

John Rose of Buffalo NY,  
Having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with Charles Townsend, John L. Kimberly and George Coit of the same place

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Brig or Vessel called the Boston of Buffalo whereof E. M. Ernst is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan Ohio in the year 1842 as appears by Her Enrollment dated at the Port of Buffalo NY. Oct 17<sup>th</sup> 1842 N. S. now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is Ninety one feet and three inches her breadth Twenty three feet and two inches her depth Eight feet and nine & a half inches and that she measures One hundred & sixty five tons seven ty five ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has One Deck and Two Masts and a scroll head.

And the said John Rose having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek in the said District, this twelfth day of May in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-five
