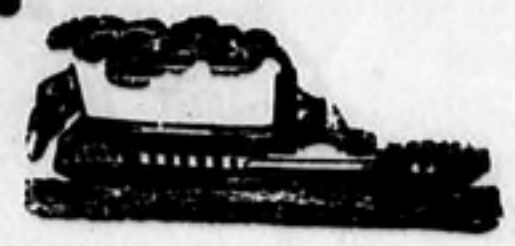

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with Erasmus D. Robinson of the same place & Benjamin T. Kercheval & Charles T. Sichel of Detroit Michigan being

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Schooner _____ or Vessel called the President of Buffalo _____ whereof Miriam M. Henry _____ is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn _____ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Stock Piles Ohio _____ in the year 1841 as appears by the Enrollment dated at the Port of Buffalo N. York June 14th 1842 No. 34 now renewed having changed names _____

And the said Enrollment _____ having certified that the said Schooner _____ or vessel has one Deck _____ and two Masts _____ and that her length is Eighty six feet and ten inches _____ her breadth Twenty feet and three inches _____ her depth Eight feet and nine inches _____ and that she measures One hundred thirty nine tons thirty three ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner _____ has no gallies _____ and a Scull _____ head.

And the said Peter L. Parsons _____ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner _____ has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
