An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Schooner _____ or Vessel called the
Mountainer of Silver Creek whereof Charles Huntley _____
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn _____ is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Silver Creek N.Y.
in 1841 & rebuilt _____ in the year 1845 as appears by her License (being under
20 tons) dated at Buffalo New York the 5th day of June 1845 N.Y. now
surrendered having been rebuilt as appears by the Certificate of Charles
Huntley Shipwright & S. H. Lachs of Surveyor filed in this Office this day,
and the said License & Certificate _____ having certified that
the said Schooner or vessel has one Deck _____ and two Mast and that her
length is Forty two feet and six inches _____
her breadth Fourteen feet and six inches _____
her depth Four feet two & a half inches _____
and that she measures Twenty two _____ tons Seventy three ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner _____ has no gallies _____
_____ and no figure _____ head.

And the said Charles Huntley _____ having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conform-
ity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner _____ has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
