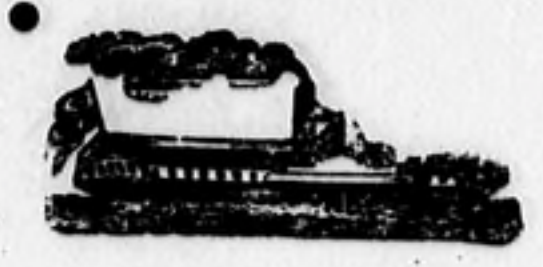

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Richard Sears of Buffalo New York
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with John M Griffith of the same place Sylvester F Alwood Thomas Clark 2^d and Duncan G Forgy the being the Firm of Alwood Clark and Forgy of Maumee City Ohio.

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Steam Boat or Vessel called the City of Buffalo whereof Sylvester F Alwood is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Maumee City Ohio in the year 1845 as appears by the Certificate of F. W Jones Shipwright and A. D. Stebbins Surveyor filed in this Office

And the said Certificate having certified that the said Steam Boat or vessel has five Decks and one Mast and that her length is One hundred & Eighty two feet six inches her breadth from keel seven feet and six inches her depth Eleven feet four & a half inches and that she measures One hundred Forty six tons Forty seven ninety-fifths that she is a Steam Boat has no galley and no head.

And the said Richard Sears having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
