

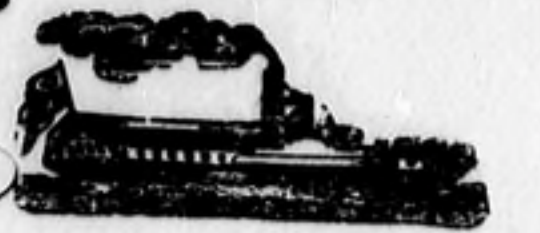

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838. Ansel R. Cobb of Buffalo (New York) having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with John Palmer of Whitesboro (New York)

sole owners of the Steam Boat or Vessel called the Indiana of Buffalo whereof J. J. Pratt is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Toledo Ohio in the year 1842 as appears by her enrollment dated at the Port of Maumee by the 15th day of April 1845 now surrendered having changed Owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Steam Boat or vessel has two Decks and one Mast and that her length is One hundred + Seventy four feet her breadth Twenty six feet her depth Twelve feet and four inches and that she measures Five hundred + thirty four tons fifty two ninety-fifths that she is a Steam Boat and head.

And the said Ansel R. Cobb having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
