

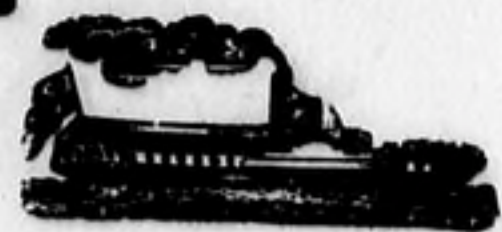

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Along J Ford of Black Rock New York
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the Canal Boat or Vessel called the
Oscar J Ford whereof Along J Ford
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo NY
in the year 1841, as appears by the Certificate of A. A.
Lanskyke Shipwright & M. S. Luther Surveyor dated August 22 1845 &
filed at this office

And the said Certificate having certified that
the said Canal Boat or vessel has One deck and that her
length is Twenty eight feet and eight inches
her breadth Thirteen feet & Nine inches
her depth Four feet and Seven inches
and that she measures Thirty six tons Sixty eight ninety-fifths
that she is a Canal Boat has No gullies
and No figure head.

And the said Along J Ford having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conform-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
