IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Henry W. Kirme of Buffalo Erie County (New York) having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES sole owner of the Schooner _____ or Vessel called the *Philadelphia* whereof John O. Corwin _____ is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn _____ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at _____ in the year 1836 as appears by the copy of her Enrolment filed in this Office 8th day of June 1842, the original having been lost as appears by the certificate of John O. Corwin filed in this Office 26th of September 1845 And the said copy of her Enrolment _____ having certified that the said Schooner _____ or vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Seventy-nine* feet and *Six* inches her breadth *Twenty-two* feet and *ten and a half* inches her depth *Seven* feet *eight* $\frac{1}{2}$ inches and that she measures *One hundred & twenty-two* tons *Seventy-two* ninety-fifths: that she is a Schooner _____ has *one* galley _____ and a *Ball* _____ head.

And the said Henry W. Kirme _____ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner _____ has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
